#### **Invitation for E-Auction**

#### 1.1 Brief Introduction

- 1. The expression of interest was called on 5-5-2022 from the eligible bidders for VTCC. However, there was no response of the said expression of interest. Therefore, a suggestion was called from the Dean, Bombay Veterinary College, Parel and as per his suggestion, the eligibility criteria and the basic price of veterinary plot needs to be relaxed. Accordingly, now it is decided to minimize the basic price of the veterinary plot on the basis of Government G.R. of Revenue and Forest Department dated 1-5-1984.
- 2. 19<sup>th</sup> Animal census by Government of India revealed presence of 1,95,448 animal population within the jurisdiction of Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai consisting of cattle, buffaloes, sheep/goats, donkeys, pigs, poultry and dogs. Pet dog population was estimated to be of 35,572 in Mumbai. Further Census of stray dogs conducted by MCGM in the year 2014 showed revealed 95,172 stray dog population in Mumbai.
- 3. Veterinary Treatment and Care Centre means an institution under the charge of registered veterinary practitioner where various veterinary services will be available.
- 4. In case of a medical emergency in animals, hospitalization facilities are not available in Mumbai, except at Bai Sakarbai Dinshaw Petit Hospital for Animals at Parel. Pursuant to the pet dog / cat population in Mumbai, provision of veterinary treatment and care centre facility in Mumbai is the need of the hour. In DCPR 2034, there is a MHADA plot reserved for Veterinary Treatment and Care Centre at Bandra (W). The said plot is situated on CTS. No A/791 admeasuring approximately 1125.00 sq.mts. with title in the name of Mumbai Board /MHADA.

#### 1.2 Purpose of E-Auction:

This invitation for E-Auction aims to:-

- Establish a Veterinary Treatment and Care Centre at CTS No.A/791, Village Bandra at Bandra Reclamation, on plot admeasuring 1125.00Sq.mt..
- Operation and maintenance of Veterinary Treatment and Care Centre for an initial period of 30Years and can be extended further, if services provided satisfactorily for a further period of thirty plus thirty years
- Provide any of the veterinary treatment facilities and its ancillary services for domestic pets as listed in Appendix 1.

This Invitation for E-Auction document indicates the purpose,, eligibility requirements, forms and procedure for submission of proposal for interested participants. Those applications meeting the Eligibility Criteria shall only be evaluated and short listed further to participate in the E-Auction. Mumbai Board / MHADA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the

# 1.4 <u>Eligibility Criteria of Entities For Participation & Application submission Process:</u> Submission of application

MHADA invites applicants for E-Auction of the plot for Veterinary Treatment & care centre(VTCC) from Charitable public trusts registered under Bombay / Maharashtra Public Trust Act 1950 or Indian Trust Act 1880 or Co-operative Societies registered under Societies Registration Act 1860or registered Non-Government Organisations for Establishment and Management of Veterinary Treatment and Care Centre at CTS No.A/791, Bandra Reclamation, Bandra (W), Mumbai – 400050,The Entity should have/OR Applied for including ,"animal welfare / setting up of Veterinary Centre or similar" as one of the Object of the trust / society/NGO with the statutory authorities, at the time of submission of application for E-Auction of the VTCC plot

#### Eligibility Criteria:

All interested participants are hereby informed that only those who meet the following eligibility criteria shall be considered for further E-Auction.

- 1) Charitable public trusts registered under Bombay / Maharashtra Public Trust Act 1950 or Indian Trust Act 1880 or Societies registered under Societies Registration Act 1860 or registered Non-Government Organisations. (hence forth any of above known as Entity).
- 2) The entity should have been in existence for at least last fifteen years at the time of Application. The Entity should have/OR Applied for including, "animal welfare / setting up of Veterinary Centre or similar" as one of the Object of the trust / society/NGO, with the statutory authorities, at the time of submission of application for E-Auction of the VTCC plot
- 3) The participant shall not have been black listed in India. (In support of this self attested undertaking on Rs. 200/- stamp paper should be submitted)
- 4) The entity shall have cash and cash equivalents including investments in FD's, mutual funds, publicly listed shares, bonds, debentures of minimum Rs. 5.00 Cr.as on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

Documents to be submitted at the time of submission of application.

The applications shall be complete with the following documents:

MHADA reserves the right to reject any or all the Applications regarding Invitation for E-Auction without assigning any reasons thereof.

## 1.5 Special Development Conditions For Succussful Bidder:

- 1) Payment of land premium should be made in 5 instalments over a period of five years. If delayed, interest as per MHADA's prevailing policy shall be applied.
- To provide free treatment facility to stray animals at 5% daily capacity of OPD. In addition, the VTCC shall provide concessional treatment to pets owned by MHADA employees at 5% daily capacity of OPD.
- 3) The name of MHADA shall be displayed on the premises and in the official paperwork of the VTCC.
- 4) The successful bidder shall have to establish an OPD and casualty facilities with mandatory ambulance services.
- 5) Lease rent at 2.5% of the upset price of the land premium will be charged per annum.
- 6) The plot under consideration is reserved for VTCC which is offered as per Government Resolution of Revenue department MHADA policy for calculating the upset price at 25% of Ready Reckoner for the prevailing year and the E Auction is being held to explore the maximum value of the plot to avoid financial loss to MHADA.
- 7) The highest bidder in the E-Auction will be declared the successful bidder. In the event of a single bidder bidding for the plot, the same may be awarded to them if they are willing to pay above the upset price of the plot.
- 8) Commercial use up-to 15% would be permissible as per the provisions of DCPR 2034 for MCGM region.
- 9) The operations of VTCC shall commence within Three years from the date of allotment of the plot.
- 10) The plot has a building potential as per DCPR 2034. The successful bidder shall get 1 FSI as basic FSI of the plot initially and shall have to pay premium to MHADA to avail balance FSI, which the entity can as per DCPR 2034 provisions.
- 11) The services mentioned in Appendix 1 may be outsourced by the allottee to the vendors having domain expertise as per rules and regulation of MHADA/Animal Husbandry department of Maharashtra.
- 12) The successful bidder shall maintain the Veterinary Treatment and Care Centre in hygienic conditions

at all times.

- 13) The Veterinary Treatment & Care Centre shall be open to all without discrimination on the ground of religion, caste, creed, race, domicile, language or income or otherwise.
- 14) Development shall be as per DCPR 2034,MCGM.
- 15) The plot is offered on "as is where is basis". There may be minor variation in the plot area. FSI will be available as per DCPR 2034,MCGM.
- 16) Sub-division of the plot shall not be permitted.
- 17) The plot shall be used for constructing and running a Veterinary Treatment & Care Centre for the purpose mentioned in this E-Auction Document

#### 1.6 Preliminary Examination For The Applications

- a) The MHADA shall examine the applications to determine whether they are complete & eligible, , whether the documents have been signed as indicated in this document, whether all Forms as asked have been filled in properly, whether applications are generally in order and all information as indicated under various clauses have been furnished.
- b) The MHADA reserves the right to waive minor deviations in the proposal application if they do not materially affect the capability of the participant to perform the assignment.
- c) Prior to detailed evaluation formalities, MHADA shall determine the substantial responsiveness of each application to the Invitation documents. A substantially responsive proposal is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Invitation document without any material deviation. A material deviation is one, which limits in any way responsibilities and liabilities of the participant or any right of the employer as required in this document. MHADA may waive any minor non-conformity in an application, which does not constitute material deviation. Non- responsiveness shall run the risk of rejection.
- d) The evaluation shall be carried out on the basis of data available in the application documents received in the first instance. However, MHADA reserves the right to call for such clarifications confined in scope to the contents of the application, should such a clarification become necessary for proper judgment in evaluation.

### 1.7 Evaluation Criteria & Fvaluation Communice For Applications.

The procedure of evaluation of the applications is indicated below:

- a) MHADA has specified the Eligibility Criteria (Clause) in the Invitation for E-Auction document. The applicant shall submit the proposals in the same sequence.
- b) MHADA will verify the applications. MHADA will allow only the Participants, who meet all the Eligibility Criteria, and who have applied successfully by submitting all the specified documents to further participate in E-Auction.

The participants would have to submit documents as given above to qualify for the E-Auction. The evaluation committee for evaluating the process will comprise of the following members:-

Step 2: Login with user credentials and verification OTP sent to registered email id and mobile number for secure Login.

Step 3: Select Live Tender from Dashboard

#### Step 4: Pay E-Auction processing fees

Processing fee of Rs. 59,000/- (fee 50,000 + Applicable GST18% Rs.9000/-) (non refundable)to be paid online or RTGS in the Account No. 60419757221 of Chief Account Officer /Mumbai Board, Bank Of Maharashtra, Bandra (East) Branch, IFSC Code No.MAHB0000164. Print receipt option is available.

Step 5: Conduct of E-Auction/online auction: As per time schedule, bidder shall participate in E-Auction by logging in the website. During E- Auction every bidder can bid in multiple of 50,000/- only. Any bidder who has bid for a specific amount, the bidding window shall remain open for next ten minutes within which time any other bidder can bid for. In case, no other bidder bids in this ten minutes time the bidding window will be closed, and the last highest quoted bidder will be the successful bidder.

#### Step 6: E-Auction Final Result:

After completion of E-Auction process, for the particular plots, the highest e-auction bidder will be the successful bidder.

#### Step 7: Refund of EMD:

After completion of E-Auction and approval of Competent Authority, the EMD amount received from Bidders other than the highest Bidder will be returned without interest, online into the Bank Account provided by the bidder at the time of Application.

\*Note-The E Auction is an end to end online process. The bidders may participate remotely in the auction process. Alternatively, if they want/need, they may assemble in the ICT conference room, Room No 247, First floor at MHADA office, Bandra E at the appointed time of the auction with their computer/devise to participate in the E Auction.

#### 1.8.2. Validity of Offer/Bid

The applicant / bidder shall keep application/ bid valid for acceptance by MHADA for period of 15 days from the date of E Auction . The applicant / bidder shall not withdraw application/bid till the E Auction process is completed . If applicant / bidder withdraws application/bid before 15 days , EMD paid by the applicant / bidder

will be forfeited. If required on the administrative ground, the validity period of applications / bids received may be extended for further period of time for which no separate intimation shall be sent. If first highest (H1) bidder fails to make the required payment within a period of 30 days from the date of acceptance of bid, then , the second highest bidder (H2) will be offered the plot

#### 1.8.3 The E.M.D. of the successful applicant shall be forfeited if:

- i. Applicant withdraws / revokes his / her application or modifies / changes the same during the validity or if after the acceptance of his / her application, the applicant fails or neglects to furnish the balance amount of plot as mentioned in the document.
- ii. MHADA reserves the right to revoke the allotment of plot on non payment of dues as per the schedule iii. Applicant fails to execute Agreement to Lease within the prescribed time limit.

#### Refund of EMD:

The Bid once made shall remain valid for acceptance by MHADA till from the last date of receipt of the Bid and it cannot be revoked or varied by the bidder. No charge back cases shall be entertained/considered for any reason. The EMD will be refunded to un-successful bidders without any interest only after completion of E-Auction activity & final approval of the Competent Authority. No EMD refund request made before completion of E-Auction will be accepted/considered/entertained. The EMD will not be adjusted against any other scheme.

#### 1.8.4 General Terms & Conditions:

The building plans shall also require aesthetic approval from MHADA.

All necessary approval and building permissions should be obtained from Local Town Planning authorities like Planning Department of MHADA/ Mumbai Municipal Corporation . DCPR 2034 shall be applicable in addition to the above conditions as applicable.

#### 2 INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

Interested bidders who meet the Eligibility Criteria and who have applied successfully may participate in E-Auction.

#### 2.1 Authorized Signatory

The "Applicant" mentioned in the Application document shall mean the one who has signed the Application document forms. The applicant should be the duly Authorized Representative of the Entity, for which a certificate of authority/resolution should be submitted. All certificates and documents (including any clarifications sought and any subsequent correspondence) received hereby, shall, as far as possible, be furnished and signed by the Authorized Representative.

Every sheet and all forms complete in all respects shall be signed by the person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the participants with affixing the rubber stamp. Any / all corrections / alterations made in the offer shall be duly authenticated by the signature of the Authorized Signatory.

#### 2.2 Amendment to Invitation for E-Auction

At any time prior to the last date for receipt of proposals, MHADA, may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective participant, modify the Invitation for E-Auction document by an amendment. In order to provide prospective participants reasonable time in which to make the amendment in preparing their proposals, MHADA may, at its discretion, extend the last date for the receipt of proposals and/or make other changes in the requirements set out in the Invitation for E-Auction

The participant is required to visit the <u>www.mhada.gov.in</u> website for any changes or amendments in the invitation for E-Auction before their submissions.

#### 2.3 Rejection of Application:

The application is liable to be rejected if:

- i. Not in prescribed forms and not containing all required details.
- ii. Received after the expiry of due date
- iii. Applications not accompanied with supporting document(s).

#### 2.4 Disclaimer

MHADA shall not be responsible for any late receipt of applications for any reasons whatsoever. The applications received late will not be considered.

The successful bidder will be entitled to sign Lease Agreement of land for 90 years on the terms of renewal of lease agreement every after 30 years, with MHADA as well as MOU with MHADA pertaining to the operation and maintenance of Veterinary Treatment and care centre for next 30 years, which will be further renewed if the applicant meet all the terms and conditions of the Lease Agreement, as per the MHADA policy
